

Dr. L. Granelian, Prof. of Economics, Bharathidaran University, Trichy appreciated the syllabi presented by the HOD's of various departments. The following recommendations are suggested by him.

- * In UG and PG programme, two extra papers to be offered in core courses.
- * Maximum credit assigned for core courses; UG - 5 credits and PG - 4 credits
- * In each core course vi unit may be included to educate the students in the recent developments of that course. It will be included only for internal

assessment not for external examination
 * Dr. Rama Moorthy, District Medical Officer, Uppiliyakudi, Pudukkottai appreciated the Ability Enhancement committee (AEC) - Yoga and health in programme.

- He insists to increase the UG credit from 140 to 160.
- Common papers like Tamil and English (name of the each paper) should be included in all syllabuses.
- Dr. A. Tholappan, Professor Department of Education (CDE) Bharathidaasan university Tiruchirappalli, appreciated the syllabi presented by the HOD's of various departments. The following recommendations are suggested by him.
 - In partA questions, multiple choice questions, choose the best answers and ~~match~~ the following, fill in the blanks types of question should be followed.
 - To conduct quiz competitions for all the subjects.
 - In Tamil medium UG courses, Tamil Medium books should be included in all UG courses Viz: Physics, Zoology, Maths, Chemistry, Economics and History.
 - At the end CCCD Director and the academic council members recommended the following to be implemented for 2022-23 onwards.
 - For I UG and I PG two test pattern to be followed for Continous Internal Assessment.

- To increase the fees from Rs.400 to Rs.500 in SSL for those who are identified as economically weaker section.
- To increase the TA and DA for inter college tournament amount from Rs.100 to Rs.250 for sports students.
- Proposals were send for Msc Botany, Bsc Botany T/M,Phd in commerce approvecd.
- Special camp with 150 students in the adopted village Thirumalarasa samudram, Sudalaipatti, Uppupati approved.
- In YRC Dental awareness camp approved.
- In PTA general body meeting shortly to be held approved.

After the comments, suggestions and recommendations from the academic council members, the member secretary Dr.B. Buvaneswari announced that syllabi and the above extra curricular activities have been passed in the academic council.

All Heads of the department presented the Syllabi for UG and PG courses which is framed by the Board of studies meeting in their respective departments.

Dr. V. Rajesh Kannan, Director, CECB, Bharathidhasan University appreciated all the faculty members and made the following suggestions.

- 75% of the TANCHE syllabus can be kept as such and 25% of the syllabus can be changed.
- Reference books with recent editions should be maintained mentioned.
- Invited the HODs to verify the sequence of papers for the semester.
- Gender studies and Yoga paper must be included in the curriculum.

Dr. A. Thelappan, Professor, Dept. of Education, Bharathidhasan University appreciated the syllabus presented by HODs.

- He suggested that we should maintain uniqueness in our syllabus and local needs should be added to our syllabus.

Dr. Thirukumaran, Professor, Department of Animal Science, Bharathidarsan University suggested that for some courses TANCSE syllabus was really excellent. and for some courses modification needs to be done.

Dr. V. Alibaba, Professor, Department of Education, Bharathidarsan University appreciated the syllabus presented by various departments.

Mrs. Revathi, Advocate specified that law rules should be informed to all students.

- * Part I Tamil can be kept common for all VH courses
- * For B.Sc C.S, the Council approved the changes in I Allied paper. Second allied can be physics.
- * For B.Sc Physics, I Allied can be Mathematics and II Allied can be Chemistry.
- * For VH Courses, Number of electives can be kept as 4 electives.

At the end of the meeting, CCCD director and all its academic council members recommend the syllabus to be implemented from the academic year 2023-24 onwards.
