

1. OBJECTIVE

We, the students of III B.Sc., Computer Science planned an awareness programme about Corona Virus to nearby villages as part of our extension activity. Since this virus has started its spread from China to other countries at a faster rate, people should be educated about its precautionary measures to prevent this virus affecting them. We have chosen Thiruvarangulam and Kadayakkudi for this corona awareness programme and we visited these places on 14.02.2020 and 17.02.2020 respectively.



2. THIRUVARANGULAM

HISTORY :

On the first day 14.02.2020, we started our awareness programme from Thiruvarangulam about corona virus.

Thiruvarangulam is a village situated in Thiruvarangulam Union, Pudukkottai district. It is known for the famous Arangulanathar temple. There is a very big pond at the back side of the temple. It is said that the village gets its name because of this pond which is called 'kulam' in tamil. This temple was built by the king Karikala Cholan. The chief deity of this temple is Arangulanathar who is also called as Haritirartheswarar. Vaikasi Visakam and Aadi Pooram are the famous festivals celebrated here.

- Theppakkolam street
- Kadaiveedhi
- Thiruvarangulam union office
- Thiruvarangulam Government Higher Secondary School.

TEMPLE:

We started our awareness programme from temple.

Then we briefly explained about the corona and its definitions to the public who work were working outside the temple and also to those who came to worship. We told that, there are a lot of chances from public places for cause of diseases. So, we instructed people to use

kerchiefs at public places to avoid micro organisms spread. We also advised them to use the public places cleanly without any misuse.



THEPPAKOLAM STREET:

Then, we entered the street near by temple and made awareness to the people inside the home. Then went to every house and told about the necessity of cleanliness, how corona spreads among people and the preventive measures of corona. We advised them to full-cook non-vegetarian food. We showed a step by step demonstration about washing hands cleanly to the children and adults. They all followed our demo with zeal. Then we went to all houses on the street and explained about the corona.





KADAIVEEDHI:

We told the people in the street, that corona virus called as "COVID 19" has started its spread from china and we save to our nation from this virus threat. Then we met the president and vice president of the village and gave awareness to them and intimated them to give awareness to their village people. They listened to our talk patiently.



THIRUVARANGULAM UNION:

Then we went to Thiruvarangulam Union Office and explained in depth to the office staff about Corona, its way of spread, its prevention and precautionary measures. We gave pamphlets to everyone and told them to share this message with their colleagues and relatives. The block development officer Mrs. Nalini helped us to a greater extent in this awareness programme.

Further, we pasted pamphlets outside the Union Office to create awareness about the corona for the people who visit there. We hope that this would be very useful to the public who visiting that union.



THIRUVARANGULAM GOVERNMENT HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL:

We thought that if we give awareness to school, it will make a good reach among all the students at village side about the corona. So we entered the school. First we asked permission to the Head Master of the school to make awareness programme among the students.

He also gave good co-operation together with the teachers and students. We explained about corona with use of charts to make a perfect impact.

First we explained, what is corona? From where it is spreading now? and the precautions, preventions about corona.

We urged all the students to use handkerchiefs to save them from corona. After completion of our speech we showed them how to wash their hand properly after coming from public places. We also asked some of the students to do handwash. The students listened with curiosity. Further our college staff too described about corona.

3. KADAYAKKUDI

On the second day 17.02.2020, we started to visit some places in Kadayakudi to give the awareness about the corona virus.

HISTORY :

Kadayakkudi is a small village situated in Pudukkottai district about 10 Kms from Pudukkottai. It is famous for *Holdswarth Dam*. It was built across Vellaru river and the water is diverted to Naatukaanmai. Its length about 8 kilometres and water is utilized by the nearby 12 villages. In November 1931, Holdswarth was appointed as Diwan of Pudukkottai. He served from 1931 to 1934. He was responsible for the creation of dam so it is named after him. The village is also famous for Prasanna Raghunatha Perumal temple.

PLACES VISITED :-

- Temple(Prasanna Raghunatha Perumal temple)
- Temple street
- Temple's priest house

TEMPLE (PRASANNA RAGHUNATHA PERUMAL TEMPLE):

First, we visited the temple to start our awareness programme. We went into the temple and worshiped god. Then we went around the temple to give awareness about corona virus to people.



II. TEMPLE STREET:

We visited Prasana Raghunatha street and started our awareness to the people residing in the stree. We introduced ourselves and explained about the **corona virus** and told them to avoid sneezing, spitting in public places. They listened to us very patiently and they said that they got such a great awareness about the effects of **CORONA VIRUS**.

We gave pamphlets to them and explained about the steps of safe hand washing. Then we visited the nearby houses and gave some pamphlets to them and explained about Corona.





III. TEMPLE'S PRIEST HOUSE:

Then some of us visited to the priest house. We explained about the purpose of our arrival for extension programme and ask about the history of temple. He explained the temple's history to us and we got a voice recording of history on our phones.

Here are some features of the temple explained by him. The temple is called by people as "**Prasanna Raghunathapuram Perumal temple**". Once the Maharaja of Pudukkottai had no male heir. So for his next heir, he asked an astrologer named Mannarkudi Rajagopalachari. He advised the Maharaja to visit Rameswaram and bring sand from there and built a temple to get a male heir.

So he left for his pilgrimage to Rameswaram. On the way he stayed at Kadaykkudi. That night, the God came in Maharaja's dream and said "you don't need to take sand from Rameswaram. I'm here in this place where you are now. You dig this land and take me out from here and build a temple for me and establish that statue". By God's blessings, he built the temple successfully. In a year, the Maharaja got a male heir and named his son "**Raghunatha Thondaiman**".

He also said that every year the 'Brahmotsavam' is conducted. "Garba Utsav" is the speciality of the temple. In this world, the "Garba utsav" is conducted only in this temple. We



gave him a pamphlet and we thanked him for giving wonderful information about the temple so as very patiently.

Finally, we gave the awareness about corona virus, to all the children and people. We believe that awareness of the corona has certainly reached the children and adults in the village.

By this satisfaction, we took leave and finished our two days programme.

CONCLUSION





ANNACHATRAM MIDDLE SCHOOL:

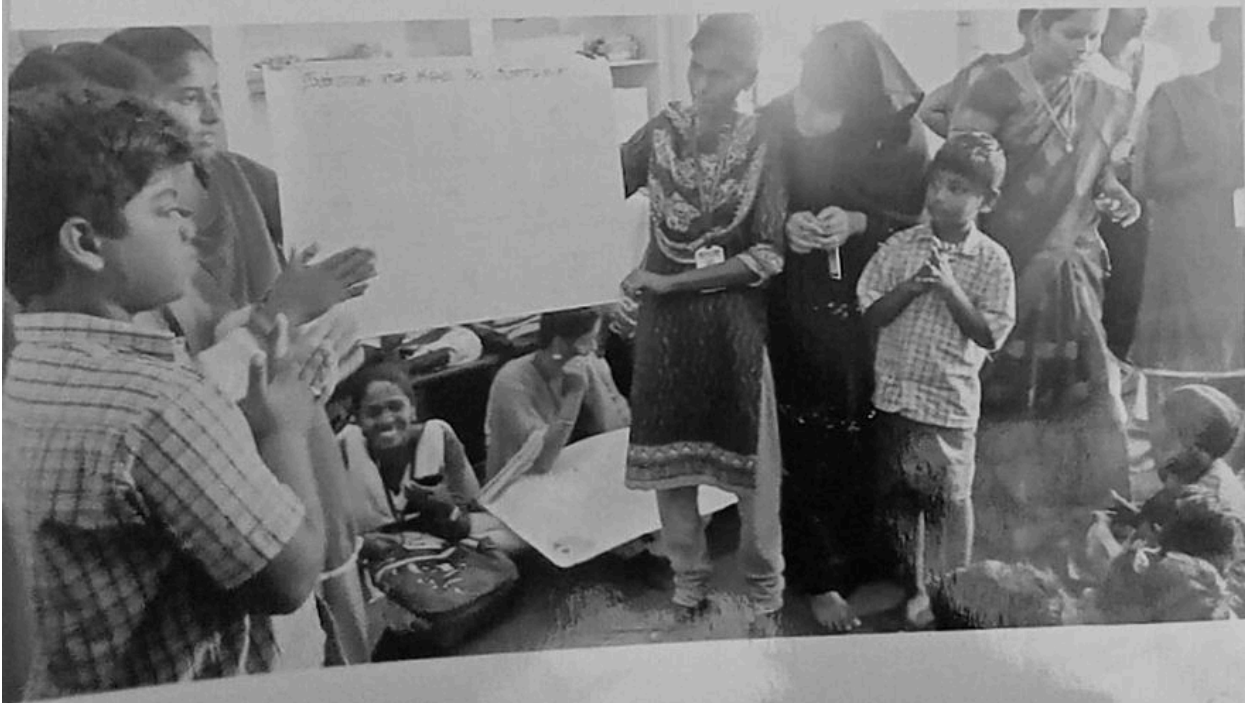

In that school, one of the staff also stated his general opinion about how disease developed? We thanked them and left the school.

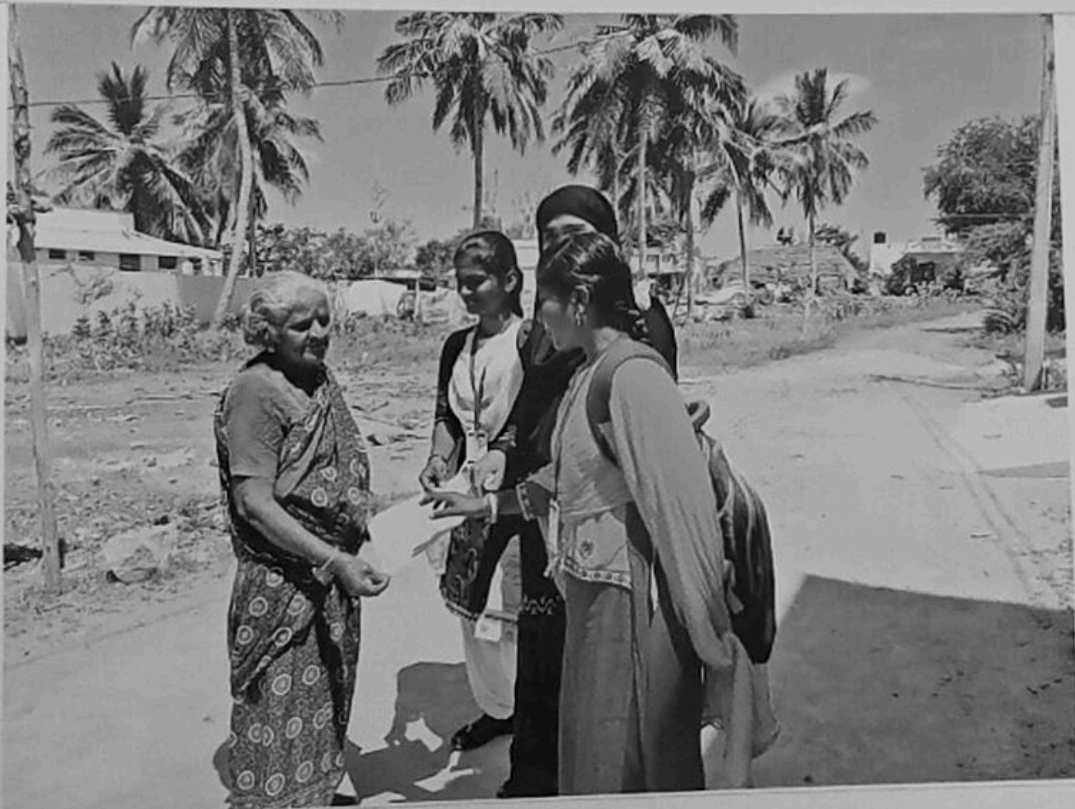


ANNACHATRAM VILLAGE

On the second day 17.02.2020, we started to visit some places in Annachatram to give the awareness about Corona Virus.

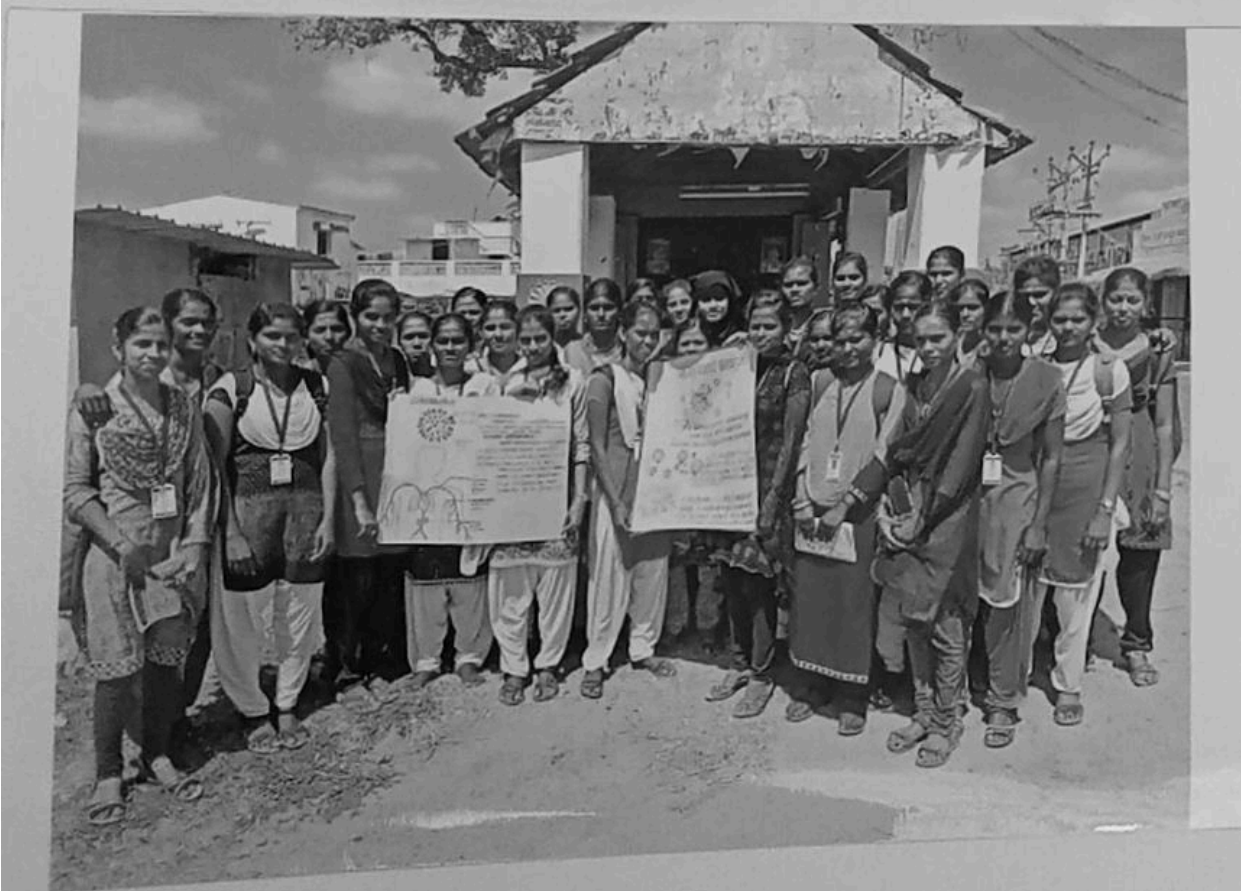

KADAIVEEDHI:

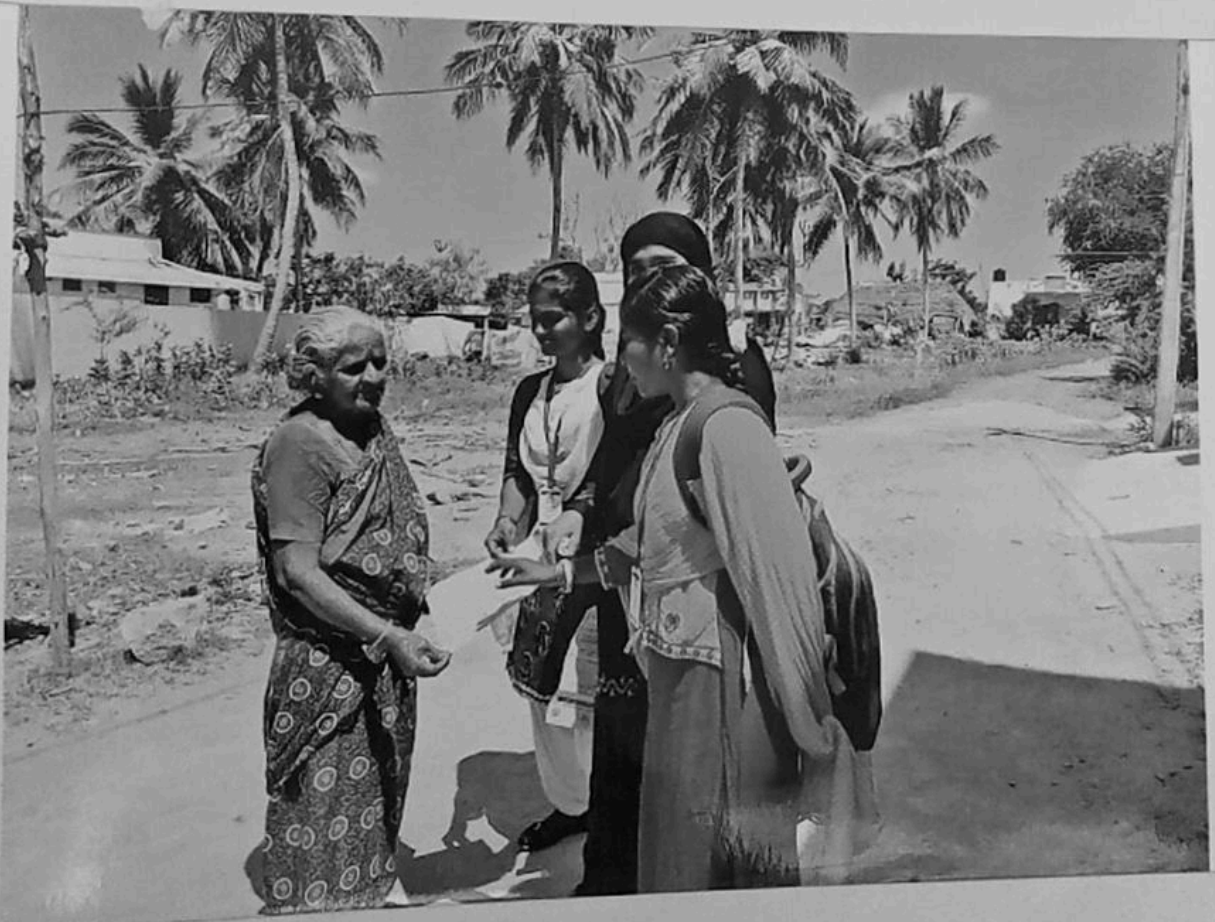
