



3.1. PROMOTION OF RESEARCH AND FACILITIES

3.1.1.3 Minutes of Governing Body

The meeting of the Governing Body was held on 06.06.2023 and the suggestions given by Prof.Y.V.Rami Reddy, UGC Nominee are the following:

- 1. The Board of studies for various programmes and the Finance committee meeting are to be conducted once in six months.
- 2. According to TANSCHE common syllabus, two credits are to be allotted for Naan Mudhalvan Courses and 142 credits must be given to all UG programmes from 2022-2023 onwards.
- 3. The strength of the regular teaching staff needs to be increased based on the students' strength.
- 4. Research papers need to be published by faculty members in Scopus/Web of Science Journals.






3.1. PROMOTION OF RESEARCH AND FACILITIES


Governing body meeting was held on 09.09.2021 and the suggestions given by Prof.Y.V.Rami Reddy, UGC Nominee are the following:



- 5. The College must apply for CPE (College with Potential for Excellence)


